In 1976, a few neighbors banded together to preserve affordable housing in the Powderhorn neighborhood of Minneapolis. More than 40 years later, PRG, has expanded to cover the Twin Cities metro area, addressing multiple issues through affordable housing development and homeownership advising.

PRG's growth has been centered around being intentional, focusing on building racial equity, and building strong partnerships with local businesses. Much of PRG's work centers on education and closing generational knowledge gaps around homeownership in communities of color in the metro area.



Their future hinges on their core strengths; the area of influence they have and the partnerships they have forged allow them to efficiently drive positive change. Making affordable housing a reality for Twin Cities residents will require continual collaboration as well as policy change, a task that PRG says is driven by their community policy advocates.
